Tribute To Yves Menard

Yves during the altimetry pioneers period

- Yves graduated from Ecole Geophysique de Strasbourg
 - Xavier Le Pichon Father of Tectonic Plates theory came from this school
- Then, he worked under the direction of Michel Lefebvre (GRGS), dealing with preliminary altimetry data:
 - Computation of mean sea surface around Kerguelen using GEOS 3
 - First use of the collinear track technique with SEASAT data
 - Validation of new improved tidal models in the English Channel from Christian Le Provost
 - Analysis of western boundary currents : Gulf Stream, Kuro Shivo

This work was the base of his PHD Thesis in 1982

First space oceanography PHD in France

- After his thesis he was hired by CNES and formally member of GRGS (now LEGOS)
 - Strong involvement in research and application of altimetry
 - Yves stayed two years in Washington with his family (1985-1986) working with Bob Cheney in NOAA

In parallel Yves conducted a high level Sport involvement, being member of the Villefranche de Lauraguais Rugby team

 Conjunction between his professional and sportive career led to a famous match between the Villefranche de Lauraguais team and a Washington Universitary team

Yves during altimetry golden ages

- After TOPEX/POSEIDON project new start decision, Yves joined in 1988 the French TOPEX/POSEIDON project team headed by Michel Dorrer, in charge of Calval activities:
 - Design and implementation of CNES calibration site in Lampedusa (Italian Island near Tunisia)
- When Michel Lefevre retired in 1994, Yves was selected as CNES Jason 1 Project scientist, working with Lee Fu, NASA project scientist:
 - In parallel Yves continued his scientific involvment in Calval activities, in particular setting up the new calibration site in Corsica

Following a serious injury Yves had to stop his sport activity as rugby player

- However he continued to be inspired in his life by the rugby spirit :
 - GIVING FEELING OF QUIET FORCE
 - HUMBLE WITHIN THE PACK
 - BUT MAKING "TERRIFIC RUNS"
 - TRYING TO HAVE TRIES (TOUCH DOWNS)
 - BEING PLAYMAKER FOR TEAMMATES
 - LEADING THE "THIRD HALF " ACTIVITIES (M. Lefevre message)
